International FoSS Master-SummerSchool in hybride format

 Seminars and talks as well as demonstrations of didactics in PE in Germany (English language) in presence with German Master students → live broadcasting to the participants of Tunisia and Jordan.

- → interaction live broadcasted (e.g. Jordan presenters tell how to play a game, Germans reanact the game and receive feedback ⓒ)
- 43 participants (18 females, 25 males)
- → all participants nearly on the same level concerning hybride format (learning by doing)

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


