

Why is a stay abroad meaningful?

- Collaboration in an international team/setting
- Acquisition of various "soft skills"
- To improve foreign language skills
- Competitive advantages over other students

Which possibilities exist to go abroad?

- Semester abroad with Learning Agreement (e.g. ERASMUS)
- Internship abroad
- Final thesis or research project abroad (Master)

When is it possible to go abroad?

- Recommendation Bachelor: 4th semester or later
- Recommendation Master: 3rd semester
- A stay abroad is also possible during the semester break/lecture-free period (3 months)

Where is it possible to go?

Whether Europe, Australia, Africa, Asia or North and South America, the Institute of Sports and Sports Science's foreign collaborations exist across the world.



How long does the preparation and the stay abroad take?

Preparation time:

- Between 6-18 months before the start of the stay
- Visa, language certificates and bureaucratic processes take a lot of time

Stay abroad:

- Usually between 3-12 months
- A minimum duration of 3 months is recommended due to the organizational effort of preparation
- Additional travel time should be planned for



4 steps to a stay abroad

Step 1: Decision-making

Step 2: Contact & application

Step 3: Clarifying financing (for scholarships refer to website)

Step 4: Apply for visa
